Camp de Benneville Pines is located at 6,800 feet in the San Bernardino National Forest, approximately 45 minutes from Redlands, CA. Within walking distance of Jenks Lake in a forest of towering cedars, pines and oaks, De Benneville is the perfect location for enjoying the natural beauty of the forest and mountains.

Accommodations include heated cabins; bedrooms for couples, families and individuals with shared baths; hot running water in all bathrooms; meeting rooms for workshops or jamming; and the hot tub for relaxing after a busy day. Deluxe accommodations include shared kitchen and living room facilities.

Delicious, homestyle meals are served in the lodge, with vegetarian and vegan options available if requested with registration.

The program for Music in the Mountain is created by Anne Redstone, Barbara Shields and other volunteers. Typically, jamming begins Friday afternoon, there is a dance with instruction on Friday evening, and late evening jams. Saturday is filled with vocal and music workshops, culminating in a camper concert that evening. Jamming continues into the night. Sunday workshops include "Songs of Meaning".
