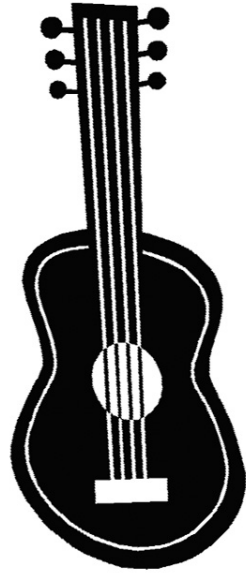


# Camp de Benneville Pines

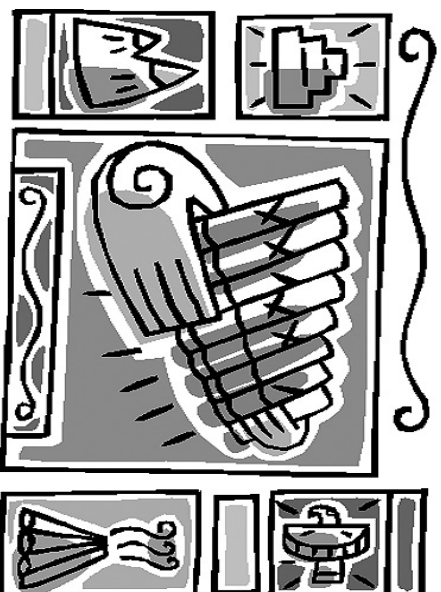
### About Camp de Benneville Pines

Located at 6800 feet in the San Bernardino National Forest, de Benneville is surrounded by towering ponderosa pines, oaks and cedars. Barton Creek is nearby and Jenks Lake within walking distance. It is the perfect location to enjoy the natural beauty of the forest.

Delicious meals are served in Hommet Lodge, with vegetarian/vegan entrees offered if requested with registrations. Cabins are comfortable if rustic, with shared bathrooms and showers. Dorms sleep six, cabin rooms sleep four and deluxe accommodations include a shared kitchen and sitting area. A limited number of double beds are also available.

Couples get first priority for double beds.
