Camp de Benneville Pines is located at 6,800 feet in the San Bernardino National Forest, approximately 45 minutes from Redlands, CA. Within walking distance of Jenks Lake in a forest of towering cedars, pines and oaks, De Benneville is the perfect location for enjoying the natural beauty of the forest and mountains.

Accommodations include winterized, heated cabins; bedrooms with shared baths; hot running water in all bathrooms; meeting rooms for workshops; and delicious, homestyle meals served in the lodge. Vegetarian and vegan options are available if requested with registration.
