Accommodations include comfortable if rustic cabins with private bedrooms for families and couples, shared baths, hot running water in all bathrooms, meeting rooms for workshops, two outdoor amphitheaters, meditation gazebos, swimming pool and hot tub (ages 14+), crafts area, archery field, basketball and volley courts. Deluxe accommodations include shared kitchen and living room facilities.

Delicious, homestyle meals are served in the lodge, with vegetarian and vegan options available if requested with registration. Registration fees include lodging, meals, snacks, workshops and activities.
